

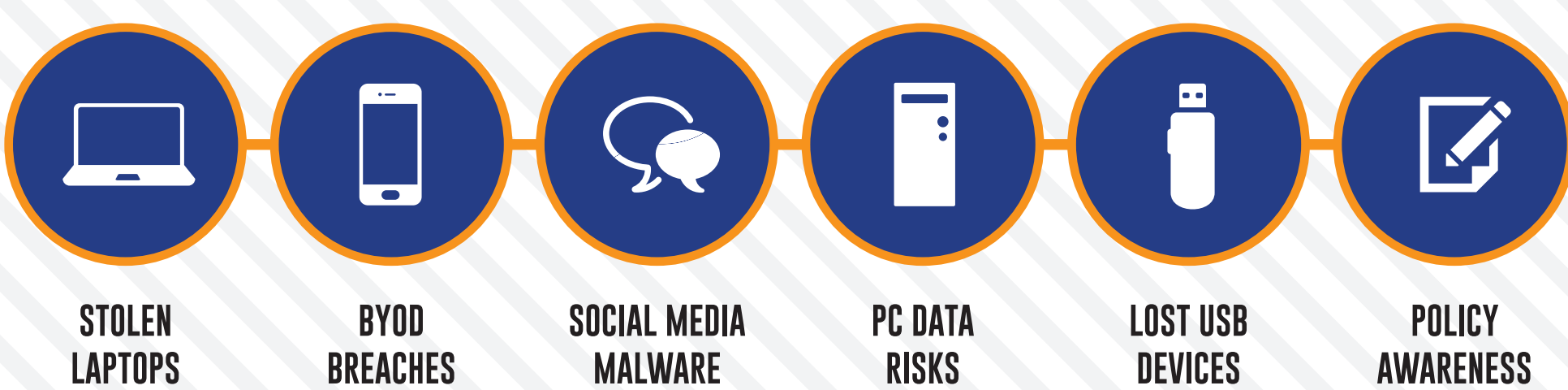

of companies that permit **BYOD** reported experiencing a **data or security breach** as a result of an employee-owned device accessing the corporate network



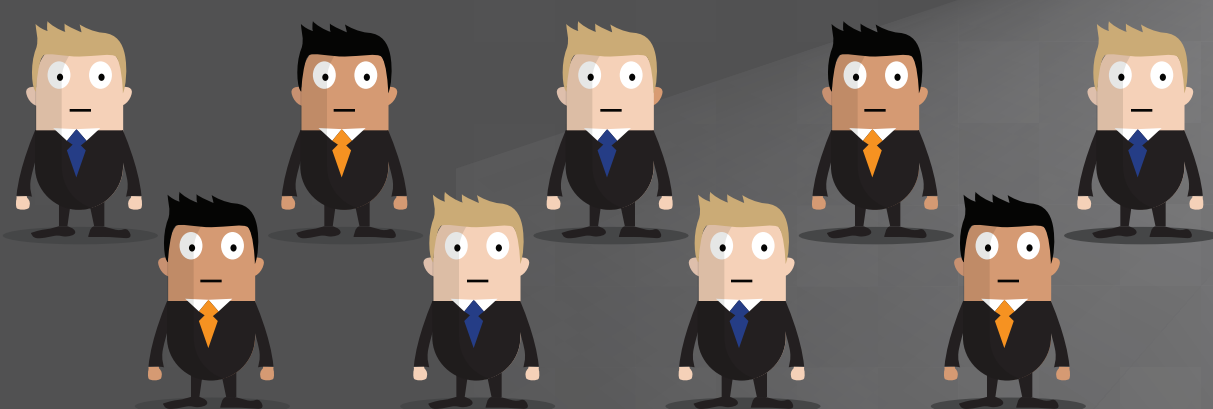

of organizations experienced an **increase in malware attacks** as a result of employees' use of **SOCIAL MEDIA**



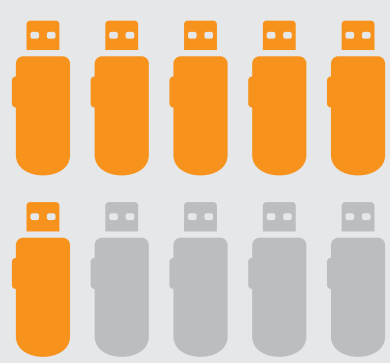

of security executives believe that **internal employees** are of top or high concern for **data vulnerabilities**



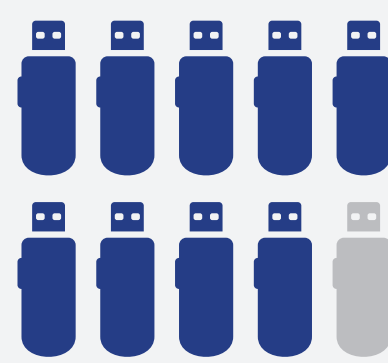
